We the Harrow Beekeepers' Association are pleased to offer a Bursary of up to £100 per annum to a member(s) who would like to attend a Bee Health course and become competent in identifying the commonly known bee diseases. This bursary will commence in 2018*.

The person(s) will need to present themselves as being competent beekeepers with at least the BBKA Basic assessment and with the intention of assisting at the annual inspection of Association apiary sites held each summer. Any interested HBKA members must complete the attached application form and submit to the HBKA Education Secretary by the deadline of 31st January.

The committee will consider all satisfactorily completed applications forms and make their final decision at the February HBKA Committee Meeting.

Please note the following:

- The bursary is intended to contribute to the cost of a 2-day course.
- Applicants are free to apply for funding towards a course being held anywhere across the UK. However there are no additional funds available for other incurred expenses, such as travel and accommodation. These must be met by the applicant.

*In the first instance this bursary will be available until 2021 i.e. until for 3 years.
Upon which time the HBKA committee will review and consider if it is to be continued.
